



## 1<sup>st</sup> Twyford Summer Camp 2017

This summer we shall be returning to one of our favourite locations for our annual Summer Camp – Normandy, France. The format of the week shall be to travel around the Cherbourg peninsular by bike, visiting many French villages en route as well as spending time on the beaches, visiting some of the historical and cultural centres and time for some water based activities.

Do not panic, if your cycling is a little rusty, or confidence is lacking – we shall be building up to the main trip with a few outings locally as well as a weekend on the Isle of Wight in May. We have run this camp many times over the years, and to date no one has found it too difficult, by the end of the week you will have cycled a memorable 250km+ and take home memories that will last for many years.

The camp is split in to patrols, with each being assigned 2 leaders – the patrols are formed by age/ability/friendships, and you will cycle and camp as patrols throughout the week, meeting up with the rest of the troop overnight and for the rest day activities.
